WEATHER

April is mid-autumn. There is the occasionally day of showery weather over the coastal suburbs of Brisbane in April but these are not frequent. Most days have abundant sunshine with minimal cloud cover. The month of April is characterized by gradually falling daily high temperatures, with daily highs decreasing from 27°C to 24°C over the course of the month, and daily low temperatures range from 16°C to 18°C, falling below 13°C or exceeding 21°C only one day in ten.
